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THE PROJECT

“A knowledge laboratory for new technologies” is an Erasmus+ project that brings together 5 European organizations with the objective of identifying best practices to improve the digital knowledge of low skilled and non-digital natives.

The rationale behind this project is that people sometimes find difficult to enrol to a structured course about new technologies because they feel afraid to be considered low skilled.

With the LabCon project we aim at creating a new methodology in-between formal and non-formal system that may support and help people in a stress-free environment.

MAIN AIM AND OBJECTIVES
